Dear KKW Summer Line Customer:

You are receiving this letter because you are a summer line customer. Over the last five years the District has implemented a systemwide water meter replacement program that is nearing completion. Our new water meters are state-of-the-art technology that can be read remotely which in turn make it easier to provide faster service and identify private plumbing leaks quickly. As a result, the summer line water meter installation process has changed.

District staff will set ALL summer line water meters starting in the Spring of 2022. Plumbers will NOT be permitted to pick up these water meters for installation. Below we have outlined the annual schedule for activation and shut down of all summer line services.

Spring:

- Weather permitting, customers can expect to have all summer lines turned on and sampled the week of April 15th.
- The third week of April, the District will set all summer line water meters and leave them in place and off at the meter valve.
- Once the water meter is at your property, you or your plumber can turn on your water and activate your service.

Fall:

- The day after Indigenous People's Day (the Tuesday after the long weekend), the District will remove all of the summer line water meters and return them to our meter shop. In 2022, the date is October 11th.
- You will be assigned the same water meter from year to year. This will create better efficiency in handling of the water meters.
- If you plan to shut down your property before this date, it is important to LEAVE THE WATER METER IN PLACE. Your plumber should shut the valve before the water meter and disconnect ONLY the house side of the water meter from your service line.

Please be sure to share these details with any one you plan to have open up and winterize your property. As always, feel free to contact us if you have any questions. Thank you.
